## Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

### Initial Claims:

During the week ending May 16, a total of 921,203 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 1,048,566 people in the week ending May 9, the fourth straight weekly decline in initial claims;

Over the most recent eight-week period, 13,336,092 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits;

Illinois and Mississippi saw increases in initial claims in the week ending May 16, while Georgia posted the largest weekly decline;

Though initial claims are subsiding, the absolute numbers remain significantly elevated, well above the peaks during the 2007-09 recession.

### Continuing Claims:


As of the week ending May 9, a total of 7,979,740 people within the Regions footprint were receiving Unemployment Insurance benefits, an increase of 1,092,010 from the prior week;

Florida saw continuing claims rise by 1,115,901 in the week ending May 9, more than accounting for the increase in the footprint as a whole. This reflects Florida processing what had been a considerable backlog of unprocessed initial claims;

Declines in continuing claims largely reflect two factors – firms putting workers back on payrolls as part of PPP requirements, and states beginning to open economic activity up. It is not possible to quantify either factor.



weekly data, not seasonally adjusted















**Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa**  
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted











 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted










**Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Kentucky**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Missouri**  
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted


















**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Tennessee**




**Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Tennessee**




