Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

Initial Claims:

During the week ending June 13, a total of 589,941 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 625,491 people in the week ending June 6, the eighth straight weekly decline in initial claims;

Since the week ending March 21, 16,134,750 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits;

Illinois, Indiana, Louisiana, and Texas saw higher initial claims in the week ending June 6, all other in-footprint states saw declines;

Though initial claims are subsiding, the absolute numbers remain significantly elevated well above levels that prevailed prior to March.

Continuing Claims:


As of the week ending June 6, a total of 6,104,755 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 6,245,580 in the week ending May 23;

Louisiana and Texas saw increases in continuing claims in the week ending June 6;

In the week ending June 6, 1,537,560 people within the Regions footprint were drawing Unemployment Insurance benefits through the Pandemic Unemployment Assistance program and the Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation program, up from 1,212,657 people in the week ending May 30.



weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Illinois weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Illinois weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Kentucky




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Missouri
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




