Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

Initial Claims:

During the week ending September 19, a total of 261,820 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, up from 254,789 people in the week ending September 12;

Since the week ending March 21, a total of 21,911,001 people within the Regions footprint have filed claims for Unemployment Insurance;

Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Mississippi, South Carolina, and Texas saw increases in initial claims in the week ending September 19.

Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending September 12, a total of 3,624,423 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 3,669,675 in the week ending September 5;


Arkansas, Georgia, Illinois, Kentucky, and Mississippi saw increases in continuing claims in the week ending September 12;

It should be noted that recent declines in continuing claims could reflect people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits as opposed to having found jobs.

More than 2.4 million people across the Regions footprint are drawing Unemployment Insurance benefits through the various pandemic relief programs; these numbers are not included in the regular claims data cited above.



weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




