Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

Initial Claims:

During the week ending December 5, a total of 317,827 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 226,036 people in the week ending November 28 (the Thanksgiving holiday contributed to the decline);

Since the week ending March 21, a total of 24,714,508 people within the Regions footprint have filed claims for Unemployment Insurance;

With the exceptions of Kentucky and Louisiana, Missouri, every in-footprint state saw an increase in initial claims in the week ending December 5.

Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending November 28, a total of 1,676,209 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 1,507,504 in the week ending November 21;


Every state within the Regions footprint to see an increase in continuing claims in the week ending November 28;

It should be noted that declines in continuing claims can reflect either people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits or having returned to work;

More than 2.87 million people across the Regions footprint are drawing Unemployment Insurance benefits through the various pandemic relief programs; these numbers are not included in the regular claims data cited above.



weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




