Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

Initial Claims:

During the week ending January 9, a total of 378,149 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, up from 289,937 people in the week ending January 2;

With the exceptions of Iowa, Kentucky, Louisiana, and South Carolina, each state in the footprint saw an increase in initial claims in the week ending January 9;

Nationally, 960,668 million people filed claims during the week ending January 16, down from 1,111,971 in the week ending January 9.

Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending January 2, a total of 1,645,785 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, up from 1,542,847 in the week ending December 26;

With the exceptions of Alabama, North Carolina, and Texas, each state in the footprint saw an increase in continuing claims in the week ending January 2;


It should be noted that declines in continuing claims can reflect either people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits or having returned to work;

More than 1.9 million people across the Regions footprint are drawing Unemployment Insurance benefits through the various pandemic relief programs; these numbers are not included in the regular claims data cited above.




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Alabama weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Alabama weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Arkansas
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Arkansas





Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Kentucky




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Louisiana
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted








Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Missouri
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Missouri


Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Tennessee
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Tennessee
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Texas
