Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

Initial Claims:

During the week ending June 12, a total of 138,097 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, up from 129,259 people in the week ending June 5;

Florida, Georgia, Iowa, Kentucky, and Texas saw increases in initial claims in the week ending June 12;

Nationally, 393,078 people filed claims during the week ending June 19, down from 407,798 in the week ending June 12.

Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending June 5, a total of 1,038,386 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, up from 1,012,907 in the week ending May 29;


Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, South Carolina, Tennessee, and Texas saw increases in continuing claims in the week ending June 5;

It should be noted that declines in continuing claims can reflect either people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits or having returned to work;

More than 2.449 million people across the Regions footprint are drawing Unemployment Insurance benefits through the various pandemic relief programs; these numbers are not included in the regular claims data cited above.



weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted








Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Kentucky




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Louisiana
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




