Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

Initial Claims:

During the week ending September 11, a total of 84,718 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 94,768 people in the week ending September 4;

Florida, Louisiana, and Missouri saw increases in initial claims in the week ending September 11, with Hurricane Ida contributing to the increase seen in Louisiana;

Nationally, 306,209 people filed claims during the week ending September 18, up from 265,902 in the week ending September 11.

Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending September 4, a total of 683,085 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 771,170 in the week ending August 28;


Alabama, Louisiana, and Mississippi saw increases in continuing claims in the week ending September 4;

It should be noted that declines in continuing claims can reflect either people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits or having returned to work;

In the week ending September 4, 764,930 people across the Regions footprint were drawing Unemployment Insurance benefits through the various pandemic relief programs; these numbers are not included in the regular claims data cited above.



weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Kentucky




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Louisiana
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted








Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi




Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




