### Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

#### Initial Claims:

During the week ending December 4, a total of 79,734 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, up from 55,759 people in the week ending November 27;

With the exception of North Carolina, each in-footprint state saw an increase in initial claims in the week ending December 4;

Nationally, 267,509 people applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits during the week ending December 11, down from 283,905 in the week ending December 4.

#### Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending November 27, a total of 554,125 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, up from 408,268 in the week ending November 20;


Each in-footprint state saw an increase in continuing claims in the week ending November 27;

Nationally, 1,712,958 people were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits as of the week ending December 4, down from 1,965,779 in the week ending November 27;

It should be noted that declines in continuing claims can reflect either people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits or having returned to work.



weekly data, not seasonally adjusted















**Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa**  
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted












**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Kentucky**














**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina**














