## Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

### Initial Claims:

In the week ending February 5, a total of 61,366 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 79,312 people in the week ending January 29;

With the exception of South Carolina, each in-footprint state saw a decline in initial claims in the week ending February 5;

Nationally, 238,432 people applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits during the week ending February 12, up from 230,740 in the week ending February 5.

### Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending January 29, a total of 495,655 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 512,144 in the week ending January 22;


Georgia, Iowa, Kentucky, and South Carolina saw increases in continuing claims in the week ending January 29;

Nationally, 1,975,407 people were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits as of the week ending February 5, down from 1,999,440 in the week ending January 29;

It should be noted that declines in continuing claims can reflect either people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits or having returned to work.



weekly data, not seasonally adjusted








**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Arkansas**


**Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Arkansas**





**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida**




**Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa**






**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Illinois**  
 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted






**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana**






**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Louisiana**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Missouri**






**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: South Carolina**










**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Texas**
