## Notes On Initial and Continuing Claims: Regions Footprint

### Initial Claims:

In the week ending July 9, a total of 69,460 people within the Regions footprint applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits, up from 62,400 people in the week ending July 2;

Nine of the in-footprint states saw increases in initial claims in the week ending July 9 while six states saw declines;

Nationally, 248,991 people applied for Unemployment Insurance benefits during the week ending July 16, up from 241,138 in the week ending July 9.

### Continuing Claims:

As of the week ending July 2, a total of 351,269 people within the Regions footprint were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits, down from 388,790 in the week ending June 25;


Seven of the in-footprint states saw increases in continuing claims in the week ending July 2 while eight states saw declines;

Nationally, 1,450,919 people were receiving regular Unemployment Insurance benefits as of the week ending July 9, up from 1,328,555 in the week ending July 2;

It should be noted that declines in continuing claims can reflect either people having exhausted their regular state-level benefits or having returned to work.



weekly data, not seasonally adjusted















**Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Florida**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Iowa**  
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted








**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana**  
weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




**Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Indiana**


**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Kentucky**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Louisiana**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Missouri**






**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi**


**Continuing Claims For Unemployment Insurance: Mississippi**


**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: North Carolina**




**Initial Claims For Unemployment Insurance: South Carolina**





 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted







 weekly data, not seasonally adjusted




