

Fort Payne was once known as the “Sock Capital of the World,” manufacturing 600 million dozen pairs annually at its peak.

The historic Fort Payne Depot was the hub of train transportation from 1891 to the 1970s. It’s now a museum and tourist attraction.

Built during the 1889 boom, the Fort Payne Opera House hosted live performances for 36 years. It’s believed to be Alabama’s oldest original theater still standing.
