At Heritage Park, a 13-foot statue honors author Alex Haley, who wrote the groundbreaking, “Roots.” Another famous writer, Cormac McCarthy, wrote “Suttree” based on his life in Knoxville.

The iconic Sunsphere, built for the 1982 World’s Fair, is 26 stories tall.

Thirty minutes southwest of Knoxville you can visit Lost Sea Adventure and explore America’s largest underground lake by boat. A 45-minute drive on the other side of Knoxville leads to Great Smoky Mountains National Park.
